West Bengal Civil Service (Executive) W.B.C.S.(Exe), is a competitive examination conducted by Public Service Commission, West Bengal, every year for recruitment to various Civil Services like- Deputy Magistrate, Deputy Collector and Block Development Officers (B.D.O.) of the Government of West Bengal. WBCS (Exe) officers may also be nominated at a later stage of their career to become All India Services (IAS) officers. Unequivocally, the examination is a gateway to the most prestigious services in the state.

THE EXAM PATTERN

Preliminary Examination

The Preliminary Examination is a screening test to shortlist candidates for further selection process. Question asked in this examination are objective in nature. Preliminary Examination is likely to be conducted in December 2025 (As per the recent Trend)

Mains Examination

Only the aspirants who qualify the Preliminary Examination would be eligible to apply for the Mains Examination. This particular examination is both objective and subjective in nature. Mains Examination is likely to be conducted September 2026(As per the recent Trend)

Personality Test

The candidates who qualify the Mains Examinations are interviewed by a Panel consisting of Members who are usually Expert from different fields chosen by the PSC. The unbiased Panel assesses whether the Candidate has the personality traits essential for various Civil Services. Questions based on matters of general interest are asked in the interview. The Panel selects Candidates who possess the basic personality traits a civil servant is expected to have.



Educational Qualification

A degree from a recognized

Ability to read, write and speak in Bengali (not required for those candidates whose mother tongue is Nepali)

Age Criteria

Age Relaxation SC/ST: 5 Years (Only from WB)

OBC: 3 Years PwD: Upto 45 Years

- 1) Criteria for the West Bengal Police Service only (i.e. Group"B" Service) - Age not below 20 years but not more than 36 years on the 1st January of the year of exam.
- 2) The candidate must have good health and character and suitability in all respects for appointment to Government service.
- 3) Please do keep in mind that the S.C./S.T./O.B.C. candidates of other States shall be treated as general candidates















DETAILED PATTERN OF EXAM

Preliminary Exam

1. The Preliminary Examination will consist of two papers: viz. "General Studies Paper- I" and "General Studies Paper- II". The Papers will be objective type consisting of 200 multiple choice questions. The papers will carry 200 marks each and each will be of 2 hours duration. The General Studies Paper will be a qualifying paper with minimum qualifying marks fixed at 33 %. It is mandatory for the candidates to appear in both the papers for the purpose of evaluation. A candidate will be disqualified in case he/she does not appear in both the papers. The standard of papers will be of the level of knowledge as expected of a Graduate of any stream.

General Studies Paper-I will include Questions covering the following fields of knowledge:

2. The Preliminary Examination is meant to serve as a screening test only for the purpose of selection of candidates for the Main Examination. The Marks obtained in this Preliminary Examination by the candidates will not be counted for merit list rather will be qualifying in nature, only those candidates who will be declared qualified at the Preliminary Examination in a year shall be eligible for appearing at the West Bengal Civil Service (Executive) etc. (Main) Examination of that year.

Mains Exam

- 1. The Main Examination shall consist of a Written Examination and Personality Test.
- 2. The Written Examination shall consist of Ten Papers of conventional type out of which two papers viz, Bengali/Nepali as paper 'A' and English Paper 'B' carrying 300 marks each shall be of qualifying in nature.
- 3. Marks obtained in all the compulsory papers (Paper-I to Paper VIII) and marks obtained in the Personality Test shall be counted for final merit List.
- 4. Each compulsory and Optional Paper shall carry 250 marks and shall be of 3 hours duration.
- 5. Candidates opting for Group 'C' and Group 'D' Services and Posts need not to appear at the Paper VII and Paper VIII.

Note: These Papers will be of Madhyamik Pariksha or equivalent examination standard and will be of qualifying nature only. Marks obtained in Paper-I to Paper- VIII of only such candidates will be taken into consideration who obtains 30 % marks or more in each of the Paper -A and Paper- B. The Marks obtained in these papers shall not be considered for Merit List

Bengali, Hindi, Sanskrit, English, Pali, Arabic, Persian, French, Urdu, Santali, Comparative Literature, Agriculture, Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Science, Anthropology, Botany, Chemistry, Civil Engineering, Commerce and Accountancy, Computer Science, Economics, Electrical Engineering, Geography, Geology, History, Law, Mathematics, Management, Mechanical Engineering, Medical Science, Physiology, Physics, Political Science, Psychology, Sociology, Statistics, Zoology.

For Botany and Political Science answers may also be written in Nepali.

Personality Test

Interview or Personality Tests for WBCS Examination is conducted for a total of 200 marks (Gr. A & B), 150 marks (Gr. C), 100 marks (Gr. D). Questions based on matters of General Interest will be asked in Interview.

Personality test assesses candidates' personal qualities such as alertness of mind, leadership traits, power of clear and logical exposition, intellectual and moral integrity, and candidate's range of interests.
